**Jeffrey (Jeff) Fuhrer** is Executive Vice President and Senior Policy Advisor at the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston, and is an advisor to the Bank's regional and community outreach department. He is responsible for the Bank's diversity and inclusion functions. He has been an associate economist of the Federal Open Market Committee, and regularly attends this key U.S. policymaking meeting with the Bank's president. In June 1992 he joined the Bank's research department as an assistant vice president and economist, and from 1995–2001 headed its Open Economy Macro/International section. In 2000 Fuhrer was named senior vice president and monetary policy advisor, in 2001 he became director of research, and in 2006 he was named executive vice president.
